FORESTRY REGULATION 2022 - SECTION 6 & 7

CLOSURE OF PART STYX RIVER STATE FOREST

FORESTRY CORPORATION OF NEW SOUTH WALES HAS RESERVED THE AREA DESCRIBED BELOW AS 'THE CLOSED AREA' FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF ITS CONTRACTORS, SUPPORT AND SUPERVISING STAFF CARRYING OUT HARVESTING OPERATIONS DURING THE PERIOD DESCRIBED BELOW AS 'THE CLOSURE PERIOD'.

THE ENTRY OF ALL PERSONS INTO THE CLOSED AREA DURING THE CLOSURE PERIOD, OTHER THAN PERSONS AUTHORISED IN WRITING BY THE FORESTRY CORPORATION OF NEW SOUTH WALES, IS HEREBY PROHIBITED.

PERSONS ENTERING INTO OR REMAINING IN THE CLOSED AREA DURING THE CLOSURE PERIOD WITHOUT FORESTRY CORPORATION OF NEW SOUTH WALES' PERMISSION ARE LIABLE TO PROSECUTION, MAXIMUM PENALTY \$2,200 PER OFFENCE.

DESCRIPTION OF THE CLOSED AREAS

That part of STYX RIVER State Forest No. 339 enclosed by the boundary commencing at the intersection of the compartment boundary and Raspberry Road (marked point 'A' on the map) moving in a clockwise direction around the closure area, generally in a southerly direction following Raspberry Road to the intersection with Sunday Creek Road (marked point 'B' on the map), and then following Sunday Creek Road in a easterly direction to the intersection with the National Park boundary (marked point 'C' on the map), then following the National Park boundary in a generally south-westerly direction to the intersection with Raspberry Road (marked point 'D' on the map), and then following Raspberry Road in a generally northerly direction to the intersection with Mine Road (marked point 'E' on the map) then following Mine Road in a generally westerly direction to the intersection with Asens Creek (marked point 'F' on the map), then following Asens Creek in a generally northerly direction to the intersection with the National Park boundary (marked point 'G' on the map), then following the National Park boundary in a generally northerly direction to the intersection with Billys Creek (marked point 'H' on the map), then following Billys Creek in a generally easterly direction to the marked point 'A' on the map. **NB. Raspberry Road is to remain open to through traffic only.**
