


Process for exploration activities to occur on State forest



Exploration activities can commence with:

 Approval to conduct exploration activity. Note: not required for 'exempt activities'

• Forest Permit (Access Arrangement)

Ministerial Consent

- # Exempted area includes land dedicated for public purposes (s30 Mining Act 1992).
- * Exempt activity Low intensity exploration activities defined in clause 10 of *State Environmental Planning Policy (Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries)* 2007. This includes:
- geological mapping and airborne surveying
- sampling and coring using hand-held equipment
- geophysical (but not seismic) surveying and downhole logging^ and
- accessing of areas by vehicle that does not involve the construction of an access way, such as a track or road
- ^ Note: the construction of the borehole to facilitate downhole logging is not exempt.
